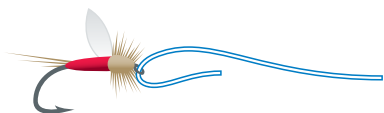
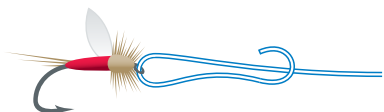


DAVY KNOT

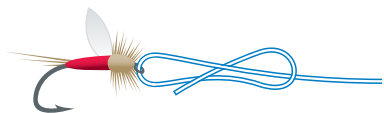
Invented by Davy Wotten. Use for tying on flies quickly, after practice there's no need to trim the tag end.



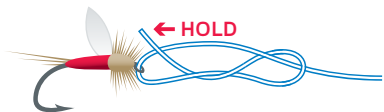
- 1** Feed the line through the fly eye.



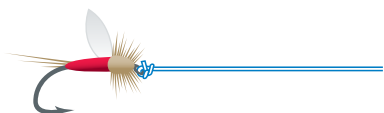
- 2** Place working end over the leader.



- 3** Wrap around the leader & through the loop that is made.



- 4** Wrap around the bottom line & back through the main loop, hold the tag.



- 5** Keeping the tag 90° to the knot, pull the leader to tighten. Trim tag end if necessary.
