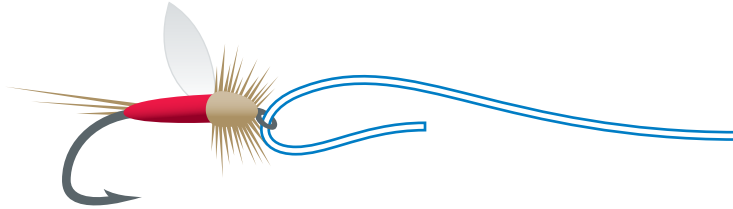
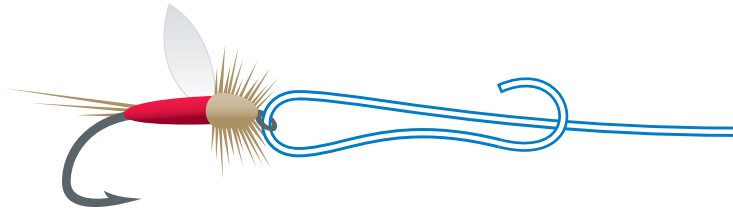


DAVY KNOT

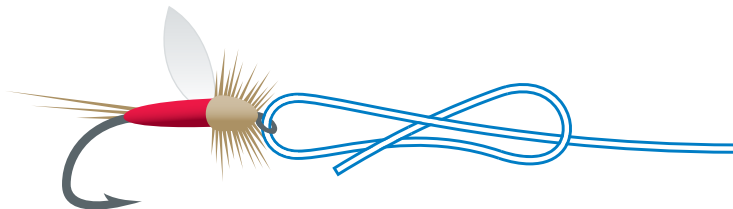
The Davy knot was invented by Davy Wotten. It's a very simple, fast & strong knot used to tie flies to your tippet with minimal wastage, none after some practice. It's known used by anglers of all skill levels all around the world.



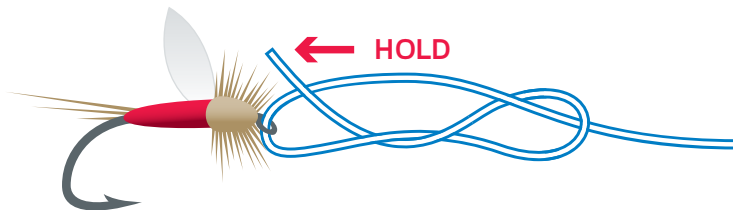
- 1** Feed line down through eye of the fly.



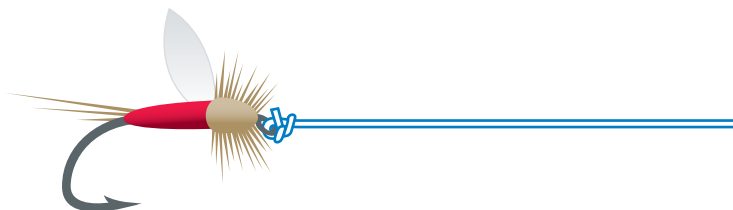
- 2** Pass line over the top & around the running line.



- 3** Feed line through over itself.



- 4** Feed back through the loop, holding the tag end.



- 5** Pull running line to tighten, keeping tag at 90° to the knot, trim tag end if necessary.
